

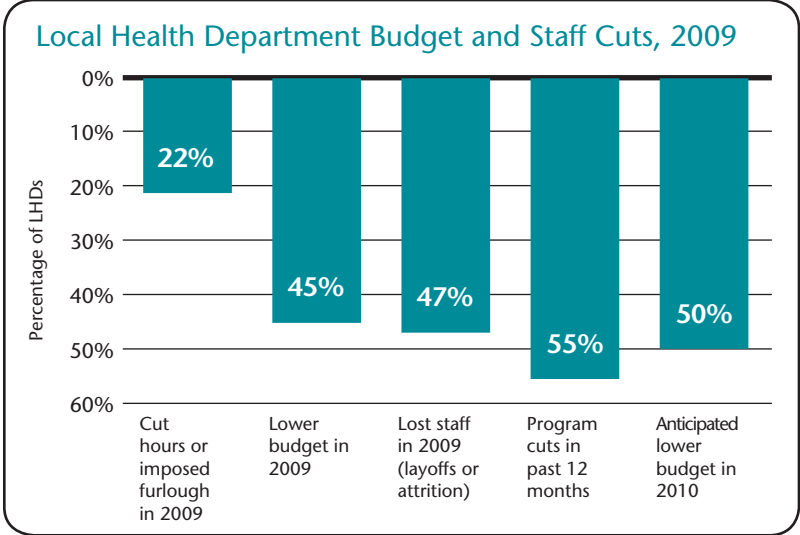


Congress Can Secure the Foundation of the U.S. Public Health System

The public health system is in steep decline. Chronic underinvestment, coupled with the impact of the current economic crisis—layoffs, budget cuts, and furloughs—has undermined local health departments’ (LHDs’) abilities to protect the health of individuals and families nationwide according to a recent survey by the National Association of County and City Health Officials.

Unless Congress fully funds the Prevention and Public Health Fund as part of healthcare reform, the nation’s public health system will be in danger of continuing to crumble at a time when health threats continue to rise. Without sufficient investment now, local health departments will experience further erosion and be unable to meet the increasing demands for services that national health reform alone does not otherwise address.
